Crunch&Sip

Our school is now a Crunch&Sip school. What does this mean? It means that the students have a set break during the school day for students to munch on vegetables or fruit brought from home and rehydrate with water. This gives students the chance to re-fuel, assisting physical and mental performance in the classroom. The break time will be at 10:00am each morning. Students are permitted to bring their fruit or veg into the classroom and eat it while they continue with their work.
