I hope everyone has a safe and enjoyable holiday.



Premier's Sporting Challenge

The students have over the term been completing the NSW Premiers Sporting Challenge (PSC). This has involved students over a ten week period monitoring their physical activity levels during class time, at recess and lunch as well as during sport lessons. Physical activity outside school hours have also been counted towards the Challenge award. The aim is to work towards an average at least 60 minutes of activity a day for ten weeks.




The Challenge has now been completed and the students have all done a marvellous job! Well done to all.

Students completing the Challenge will receive a personalised certificate (Diamond, Gold, Silver or Bronze), signed by the Premier of New South Wales. These will be presented at a school assembly.

Physical activity is valued for its physical, social and emotional benefits. It also helps young people to develop communication skills, confidence and resilience.

Premier's Reading Challenge

The students have been participating in class with the Premier's Reading Challenge. The Challenge aims to encourage a love of reading for leisure and pleasure in students, and to enable them to experience quality literature. It is not a competition but a challenge to each student to read, to read more and to read more widely. It would be great for the students to continue to read and record their reading over the holidays as these books will count towards their challenge. The closing date is August 30th.
