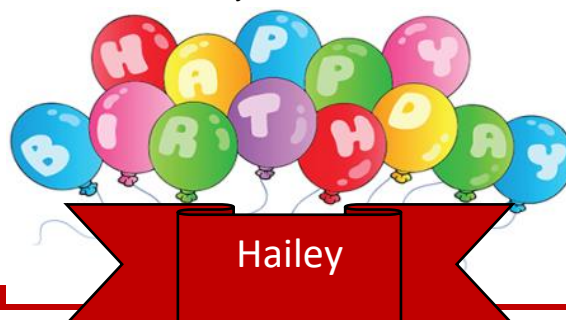
School Photos

Please note: The school cannot give change for purchasing photos, so please ensure correct change is in the envelope. The preferred way to pay is an online payment by credit card prior to the day.

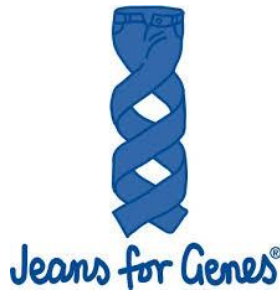
Centenary Committee Meeting

Gone but not forgotten

We have been invited by Bonalbo Central School to attend the WW1 Living History program on Thursday 29th August.

The program presents the students with a WW1 Western Front Trench experience, focusing on the experience of diggers in the trenches during 1916-1918. They bring a full size (2 metres deep but above ground) trench section into the school for students to get a true feel of their size and design.

The goal is not only to show students everything these men would have worn carried or used, but also to provide a human perspective to the war and hopefully build some empathy in the students. To do this they combine fact based story telling with primary artefacts.

The display includes uniforms, headgear and personal webbing kit that can be worn by a student or teacher in each group, plus a wide selection of weapons, tools, personal items, foodstuff and equipment that was used in the trenches.

This will be a valuable day to the students. Please see attached permission note to return to the front office.

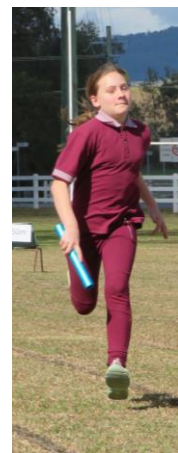
